

Missions Commission Report to Administrative Board  
July 12, 2011

Though our annual budget was significantly reduced for 2011, we continue to be active in sponsoring and encouraging service & mission opportunities. So far this year we have been involved in the following mission efforts:

1. Cleveland Food Bank - 3 trips so far this year
2. served meals at Brookside Hunger Center
3. multiple service at Cornerstone Of Hope in Independence
4. collected socks and underwear for Berea Children's Home
5. assisted UMW by recruiting and organizing volunteers for Cherry Booth at Brecksville Home Days.
6. \$1,000 contribution to support the Russian Orphanage trip. This was purely mission dollars, not for expenses of any individual.
7. \$250 Nothing But Nets
8. Camphor Mission - commitment of \$2,000 for this mission in Liberia, to be paid later in the year.
9. Easter offering: West Side Ecumenical Ministries - educational program and Red Bird Mission School n Kentucky.
10. We continue to encourage members to participate in mission opportunities through the Methodist Church and through many agencies in the community.

We still have more than 1/2 of our budget left for use in second half of the year. Our annual budget was \$7500 for 2011 and our remaining budget was \$5,898 as of May 31, 2011.
